GENERAL INFORMATION

Fees: Specific class fees are listed in the registration materials and can be found at www.gen-pac.com. Fees are due by the 7th of each month and may be paid by cash, check, or credit card. We also offer an automatic payment plan. A discount on class fees is available for those who pay the full year in advance or are on the automatic payment plan. Monthly payment is expected as long as a student is enrolled. A student will be considered withdrawn from our program when written notice is received. The fees are set up for students who are participating in the full program, not on a per class basis. There is no credit for absenteeism although we encourage all students to make up any missed classes during our regular class schedule.

Attire: All female students wear a leotard and tights to class with their hair pulled back. Males will wear a t-shirt with athletic pants or shorts. We ask that jewelry be kept to a minimum.

Spring Recital: Our recital and dress rehearsal are held at Westerville Central High School. Flash photography and Video Taping are only permitted at the Dress Rehearsal. A Videographer will record the recital and make those tapes available for purchase to parents. Tickets are available at no cost to families and their guests.

Parent Observation: Parents are invited to view classes twice a year. Observations are generally in October and April.

We will be closed for Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Winter Break, Spring Break, Memorial Day, and on the celebration of the 4th of July. We will also close for inclement weather. Please call the studio, check the website, or facebook for weather closings.

The Generations facilities are available for family, business, and community rentals.

Generations or its staff can not be responsible for lost or stolen articles, please don't leave valuables unattended. We reserve the right to cancel or move any class if enrollment is below 6 students.

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Creative Movement (ages 2½ -5) - An introductory class for the young dancer to learn ballet, tumbling, tap skills, movement, balance, coordination, body awareness, rhythm, the lyrical qualities of music and movement, as well as socialization. Shoes: Capezio or Bloch pink (girls) or black (boys) Ballet Slippers.

Tap (ages 5 and up, 4 with previous classroom experience) A form of dance that teaches the rhythmic formation of sounds created by the feet. Shoes: black Capezio or Bloch tap shoes

Ballet: (Kindergarten & up) A theatrical representation of a story through proper dance technique or pantomimic action accompanied by music. Shoes: Capezio or Bloch Pink Ballet Slippers. Pointe class available with Teacher Permission and a minimum of 3 ballet classes per week.

Jazz (Kindergarten and up) - Jazz class focuses on technical training and increasing flexibility. It includes many different styles including pop, contemporary, and hip-hop. It is a dance of body, arm and leg movements, leaps, jumps and turns. Recital dances will be in good taste and age-appropriate. Shoes: Capezio or Bloch jazz shoes. The color of jazz shoes is determined by the class level.

Jazz/Ballet Combination I a 45 minute class incorporating both Jazz and Ballet. A Jazz dance will be performed in the recital. Shoes: Capezio or Bloch Black Jazz Shoes.

Jazz/Tap Combination II (Grades K-2) This one hour class combines the fun of Jazz with the sounds of Tap. Two dances will be performed in the recital. Students need Black Jazz Shoes and Black Tap Shoes.

Tap/Ballet Combination classes There are 3 levels of this class based on the age and skill level of the students. The level I class will perform a ballet dance in the recital and levels II and III will perform both a ballet and a tap dance. Shoes: All levels will need Bloch Pink Ballet Slippers and Black Tap Shoes.

Adult: Check our schedule for adult options.

Hip Hop (Kindergarten & above) - Hip Hop focuses on the learning of steps of popular street dancing. Classical training is not a part of the curriculum. Shoes: dance sneakers or Black Jazz Shoes.

Tumbling (Ages 5 and up) Our program is geared to develop the basic acrobatic skills including rolls, cartwheels, walkovers, handsprings, aerials and other tricks. Students are barefoot for tumbling. Classes are offered for pre-school age students called Tumble Tykes and Tumble Tots.



Generations also offers a full range of competition dancing for students with previous training. We are also the home for Ballet Allongé ballet training program for those students who have a love of ballet and want to focus in this area. Contact us for more information on these options.
